The First Working Meeting of the INNOVATRAN TRANSFER project consortium was held on the 17th April 2013 in Warsaw. During the meeting the first phase of the project realization consisting in gathering the opinion of potential users regarding the content and basic functionality of the system was discussed and the outcomes from this stage were summed up. Analysis of the survey results made it possible to develop guidelines for the further implementation of the project. Also a work plan for the next six months of the project was also prepared to ensure timely implementation of all tasks.
